2. INTRODUCTION

The WKF Qualification Tournament (QT) is a closed tournament for National Federations (NF) that awards 6 quota per category to attend the Karate World Championships, -Individual World Championships-. NFs are not permitted to register athletes that are already qualified nor register an athlete into the corresponding category of said qualified athlete.

This Qualification Tournament corresponds to Phase 1 of the Karate World Championships (Individual World Championships). Phase 1 is a competition offering the opportunity to enter Phase 2 of the World Championship for those who have not pre-qualified through the ranking system and where no candidate from the applicable country is already qualified.

3. COMPETITION INFORMATION

3.2 The Draw

Without ranking or standing criteria, the draw will randomly assign athletes to groups. There is no seeding applied to Phase 1 (Qualification Tournament).

The Draw will take place on the day of official accreditation during the Coach Meeting, which will be held on Thursday, October 16th, from 18:00 to 18:30.

3.3 Competition System

The competition system is divided in Group Phase and Elimination Phase,

The Group Phase is conducted with round-robin competition within each group where the winners will advance to the Elimination Phase that will conclude in the selection of the 6 winners that will qualify to Phase 2 (Final Phase).

- The Phase 1 (Qualification Tournament) will be in Round Robin format with 6,8,12 or 24 pools of minimum 3 and maximum 6 athletes depending on the number of participants.
- 12 athletes will compete in the 6 qualification bouts.
- The winners of these 6 qualification bouts will qualify to the Final Phase.



Depending on the group size, the competition will comprise either 1 round for groups 6, 8, 12, or 2 rounds for 24 groups. The final round is the qualification bout where 12 athletes compete for a quota spot to the Karate World Championships.





21. HOW TO GET TO THE QUALIFICATION TOURNAMENT

21.1 By Air

Most international travelers arrive in Paris via Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) or Orly Airport (ORY). These airports have excellent connections to the city center by train, bus, or taxi.



21.2 By Train

The Eurostar high-speed train connects Paris to major European cities, including London, Brussels, and Amsterdam, making it a convenient option for travelers coming from these destinations.

21.3 By Bus

Several long-distance bus companies offer services to Paris from various European cities. It's usually a budget-friendly option, but the journey may take longer than by train or plane.

From Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) to the center of Paris

RER B Train:

The RER B train is a popular and cost-effective option. The CDGVAL shuttle train connects the airport terminals to the RER B station. From there, you can take the RER B train to various central locations in Paris, including Gare du Nord, Châtelet-Les Halles, and Saint-Michel-Notre-Dame. The journey takes approximately 30-40 minutes. Trains run regularly, typically every 10-15 minutes.

Airport Shuttle Bus:

Various shuttle bus services operate between CDG and central Paris. These buses have multiple stops in the city, including popular locations like Gare de Lyon, Porte Maillot, and the Eiffel Tower. The travel time may vary based on traffic conditions but typically takes around 45 minutes to an hour.

<u>Taxi:</u>

Taxis are readily available at CDG. The journey to the city center by taxi can take around 30-45 minutes, depending on traffic. Be sure to use licensed taxis and make sure the meter is running.

Private Transfer:

You can also book a private transfer in advance. This can be a more comfortable and hassle-free option, especially if you have a lot of luggage or are traveling with a group.



From Orly to the center of Paris

Orlyval Light Rail + RER B Train:

Take the Orlyval light rail from Orly Airport to the Antony station. From Antony, transfer to the RER B train, which will take you to various central locations in Paris, including Gare du Nord, Châtelet-Les Halles, and Saint-Michel-Notre-Dame. This journey typically takes around 30-40 minutes by train.

Orlybus:

Orlybus is a dedicated shuttle bus service that connects Orly Airport to central Paris. It runs from Orly to Denfert-Rochereau station, which is well-connected to other parts of the city. The journey usually takes about 20-30 minutes.

<u>Tramway T7 + Metro:</u>

The T7 tram connects Orly Airport to the Villejuif - Louis Aragon metro station on Line 7. From there, you can take Line 7 of the Paris Metro to reach central locations in the city. The entire journey may take around 30-40 minutes.

Taxi:

Taxis are available at Orly Airport. The travel time by taxi to the city center typically ranges from 30 to 45 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.

Private Transfer:

Consider booking a private transfer in advance if you prefer a more comfortable and hassle-free option, especially if you have a lot of luggage or are traveling with a group.

Ridesharing Services:

Ridesharing services like Uber are also available at Orly Airport, offering a convenient door-to-door option.
